

GK's Report

My Brothers All:

Once again, poor Camille Ng had to call and remind me to compose this report. September was a very good month for our Council. It was highlighted by two major events, the first of great spiritual value and the second of great service.

At our September 22 social meeting, our Chaplain, Fr. Coritinovis, gave us a wonderful presentation on the history, biblical basis, and theology on the Church's position on traditional marriage. His comments were of great value in understanding that God views human marriage in the context of his covenants with the Jewish people in the Old Testament, and Christ's covenant with his bride, the church. After several questions, the over 30 people in attendance enjoyed a social time with Fr. Cortinovis to talk together and enjoy some refreshments.

On September 25, our Council again stepped up and did all the meat cooking for the parish picnic. We cooked enough hamburgers and hotdogs to feed in excess of 500 people, despite a less than beautiful day. We were also blessed by the presence of several seminarians who had come out to help cook and get to know the people of our parish. They were rewarded with much food, including a pan of Mary Girardi's famous baked beans, to take back with them.

October has some big events coming up also. First, on October 15 we hope to run a blood drive in the Trumpet Room. Anyone interested in assisting, especially managing it, please call Chancellor Joe Doane immediately. The second big event is a joint meeting with the Sodality Guild on October 20. The Prefect of the Sodality, Betty Gill, has prepared a wonderful evening and I encourage all to attend. Finally, we will hold another recruitment weekend on October 23 & October 30. Be watching for details from our Membership Chairman Bill Wilkinson.

Finally, this is Respect for Life Month in our Church. In his homily today, Fr. Cortinovis reminded us that respect for life is more than being against abortion, euthanasia, and contraception. It also includes respect for the poor, the lonely, the sick, and the dying. In the Catholic Standard are many opportunities to volunteer with agencies that address all these communities. Finally, the Holy Rosary, prayed daily, fervently, solemnly is a powerful tool to ask Mary's help and guidance in how to go about giving of ourselves in respecting life in all its stages.
